**1. Apologies for absence**

Apologies for absence were received and accepted from Cllr P Mannering (family). Cllr J Herschel reported the absence of Cllr S Digby.

**2. Declarations of member's interests in agenda items**

There were none.

**3. Procurement of Parkour Facility in Flackwell Heath**

Council were asked to receive a short report from Cllr Johncock about the Parkour equipment and the quotes received. Consideration was given to the request for a contribution of £1,000 towards the total cost of the facility.

Consultation with TVP, Wycombe District Council Community Safety and Environmental Services had taken place when looking for a suitable location for the facility. Guidelines for distance from property boundaries had been also taken into consideration.

Concerns and objections to location of the facility were heard from the members of public present. They had been in contact with Wycombe District Council and were awaiting a response regarding the location.

*the Council would contribute the £1,000 requested and the Clerk place the order for the Parkour equipment based on the quotations received.*

**4. Procurement of Replacement Playground Equipment**

Council were asked to receive a short report from Cllr Willis and consider proceeding with the initial order of 2 pieces of equipment for installation at Boundary Road Recreation Ground.

the Clerk place the order for the equipment at a cost of £29,827.00***

**5. Community Orchard, Loudwater**

Council were asked to approve the purchase of 10 apple trees for the above project at a cost of £90.00 from the Community Orchard Budget line of £2,000.

In addition, Council was asked to approve the purchase of chestnut paling fencing for the designated orchard area and a small metal container **not** to exceed the budget figure.

the apple trees, fencing and container be purchased.***
