Finding 1

The seat(s) and suspension were missing at the time of inspection and the inspector was unable to make a full compliance assessment - Replace missing seat(s) and suspension

Finding 3

The wetpour is crumbing in areas - Monitor for any further deterioration and repair as required

Finding 5

Parts of the timber are rough or splintered - Remove all rough or sharp edges

Finding 7

The timber has a number of splits/shakes or air cracks and this may affect the stability or allow water ingress which will accelerate the rotting process - Monitor to ensure the splits do not cross through fixing points of the structure and/or cause any instability

Finding 2

The surfacing is severely damaged - Repair damaged areas of surfacing

Finding 4

There is surface corrosion present on the item - Consider treating the item

Finding 6

There is/are finger entrapment/s in the chains and the item fails to meet the requirements of BS EN 1176 Part 1 4.2.7.6 Entrapment of fingers - Replace the swings or remove the chains

Finding 8

There is some damage to the item - Monitor for any further deterioration and repair as required

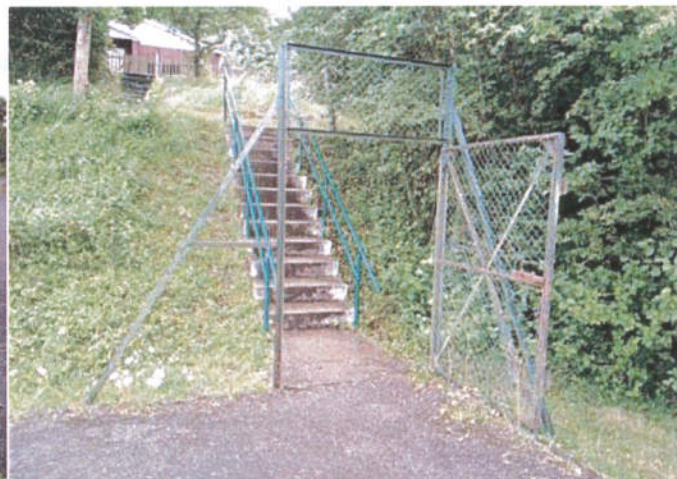

Interpretation Boards

The Residents Society Board agreed that we would like to offer to fund two projects:

a) **Information board at Widmer Pond** - which we are offering to design and fund. The idea is that the information board would be on the bank of the pond near the bench closest to the Red Lion and would be placed to straddle the boundary line between the two parishes. There is a marker stone already on the site placed in agreement some years ago by Liz Tebbutt (for CWPC) and Miles Green (for Penn). The information board would explain where the parish boundary runs and why, and add points of interest about the pond and its surroundings. We would, of course, need the agreement of both Parish Councils and are writing separately to Penn.

b) **The Queen's Platinum Jubilee** - to fund and install a notable tree in a prominent position, with appropriate ceremony and a commemorative plaque, in Tylers Green. We have not yet located any particular place for it but the Parish Council may have a suitable site in mind, or indeed may prefer to take on the project itself?
